- Research natural disasters. How many different natural disasters can you find information about? Present this in a creative way.
- **Build and/ or design an Earthquake proof city. Explain what materials you have used and why these would withstand an earthquake.**
- Create an earthquake survival pack. Think about the food you would need and the clothes you would pack. Is there anything else you would need?
- **Create a collage of volcanoes. Show the different stages of a volcano eruption and what happens after/ what the area looks like after the eruption.**
